

Your Council Tax Support Letters Explained

Please read this guide as it will help you to understand your Council Tax Support decision letters.

When you claim Council Tax Support we have to send you an Award letter and sometimes you may also receive a Statement of Reason letter. These letters show you how much Council Tax Support you have been awarded and how we have worked out your award for each period. These award(s) will be based on the details you have given us.

You should check the details of the letter(s) to make sure everything is correct. You must tell the Benefit Service straight away if you think our decision on your support is wrong.

This guide provides you with a few examples of the sorts of letter you may receive and shows how some circumstances are shown. It also explains some of the terms used on the letters.

Things to note:

If you receive Income Support, Job Seekers Allowance (Income Based), Employment Support Allowance (Income Related) or Pension Guarantee Credit, the income for these benefits will be shown as £0.00. This is because these types of benefit normally mean you would be entitled to the maximum amount of support so we don't record the actual amount you receive.

Where Universal Credit is in payment to you we will use the full award before any deductions are taken from the award.

Do you need a more detailed explanation of the Support awarded?

If you do not understand or want more details about the decision letters you can ask for a more detailed explanation. These requests should be made in writing within one month of the date shown on the decision letters.

Do you disagree with the decision?

If you disagree with our decision on the level of Council Tax Support awarded, you can ask us to look at your claim again. You will need to explain, in writing, why you are aggrieved (disagree) with our decision.

We will review your letter and will aim to write to you within two months outlining whether we can revise our original decision.

If you do not agree with our review of your claim you may appeal to the Valuation Tribunal. We will send you more details about this when we notify you on the outcome of our review.

What if your circumstances change?

You must tell the Benefit Service **straight away** about any change of circumstances which may affect your Council Tax Support entitlement.

What if I struggle to pay my Council Tax bill?


